

Our History

St Agnes College (Autonomous) Mangaluru, India, is a premier Catholic Educational Institution founded on 2 July 1921 by a great visionary Mother Mary Aloysia, the Second Superior General of the Apostolic Carmel Congregation who was the first recipient of Kaiser-i-Hind Gold Medal of the First Class in 1929, a prestigious National Award by the then British Government of India, for her contribution in the field of Women's Education. St Agnes College was the first women's college on the West Coast of India and the first, under private management, in the whole country.

Over the years, the college has grown steadily in strength and infrastructure and has withstood the vicissitudes of time and lived up to the challenges posed by changes in Higher Education. All the while the institution has kept aloft its banner declaring that 'God is My Strength'. The Institution has the distinction of producing women graduates/post graduates who hold positions in different spears as educators, scientist, charted accountants, entrepreneurs, management professionals and service professionals all over the world. The focus now is on student-centered learning, throwing open new avenues of study and specialization and on designing challenging courses to suit the student community.

The campus having over 6000 students from Nursery to Post Graduate classes is known for its academic excellence, conducive atmosphere, community concern/service, extension activities, discipline, imparting social, ethical and family values (value based education), spirit of tolerance and mutual respect and up-building.

Autonomy

To promote academic excellence in teaching and research, the Management of St Agnes College has accepted the status of academic autonomy for the College from the year 2007-08. In the autonomous set up, the college is free to frame its own syllabi for the various courses and adopt suitable innovative methods of Teaching, Learning and Evaluation. With autonomy, the College has the liberty to teach job-oriented subjects and promote service-oriented activities as also to conduct examinations and announce results within the prescribed structures of the Semester pattern. The University of Mangalore confers the degree to the qualified candidates presented by the College.

The college is now all set to celebrate the Centenary of its existence in the year 2020-21. In the course of 99 years, St Agnes College has achieved much. It was the first college in Mangalore University who took the initiative of submitting itself to the accreditation process by NAAC in 1999 and then subsequently in the years 2005, 2012 and 2017. In the fourth cycle, the college has been Re-accredited with A + with a CGPA 3.65 out of 4. The college has been recognized as a 'College of Excellence' by the UGC in 2017 and conferred with 'Star Status' by DBT, Government of India, New Delhi. The College stands in the eighth position with a rating of AAAA + (outstanding) in the list of the best colleges of Karnataka as rated by CAREERS 360 in 2016.

St Agnes College offers Under-Graduate Programmes in Arts, Science, Commerce, Business Administration and Computer application and Post-Graduate and Research in English Literature, M. Sc. in Psychology, M. Sc. in Clinical Psychology, M. Com, M. Sc. in Chemistry and M.Sc. in big data analytics. All curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are focused on providing students opportunities to enhance knowledge, acquire skills, nurture a culture of research and innovation and empower them to lead a wholistic and successful family and career life.

The Admission is open to all with special consideration shown to the less privileged Christian minority, backward communities and the physically challenged.

- Name of the student must be as per SSLC/HSC/CBSE/ICSE marks card.
- If provisional admission is made based on previous academic records, final admission will be done only after producing the qualifying examination marks card at the earliest.
- Application form will be submitted only after paying Registration Fees.
- If the student is not residing with the parents, local guardian in Mangalore is must. Please give name, address and phone number of the local guardian.
- Please keep scanned images of photograph, Photo ID Proof and other documents. All documents to be uploaded must be either. jpeg, png, .jpg, .gif, .bmp format, each of which should not exceed 2MB in size.
- Admission will take place as per the admission criteria and according to the availability of seats.
- The application has 6 sections, each section can be edited and saved at any point of time, till the final submission is made.
- Please ensure all the data entered is accurate before submitting the application. Application once submitted cannot be edited.
- Before submitting the application please read the Eligibility Criteria document provided on the dashboard for more instructions.
- Please check all the details entered before you proceed.
- Spot admission for meritorious students will be done and fees will be paid immediately.
- The candidate must be accompanied by one of her parents for Admission. Please take note that a guardian can accompany the student only if both parents are deceased.
- The candidate along with parents/guardian will attend the admission interview on a prescribed date.
- Registration/Admission fees, once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. Admission fees should be paid within the
 prescribed date.

Autonomous System

The duration of UG programmes shall extend over six semesters

The UG programme offered is structured with 100 credits for the various subjects taken for study, for the award of the Degree. The credits are allotted to every course of study based on Marks.

Students are required to participate compulsorily in the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities organized by the college as part of the credit based semester system.

Each semester shall consist of 14 weeks of study. The ODD semester will commence in June and the Even semester will commence in November

Assessment and Evaluation

The continuous internal assessment(CIA) will have a weightage of 20% and the end semester examination will have a weightage of 80% It is mandatory to appear for all the components of the CIA.

Attendance

A candidate should have 75% attendance up to the end of the semester in each to qualify to answer the End Semester Examinations. Students who do not have required attendance will not be allowed to answer the examination. They have to repeat the semester.

Dress regulations

The Students will wear the uniform prescribed by the college. No other attire is permitted in the college premises throughout the working hours. No student will wear the head scarf.

Eligibility Criterion for UG Programmes

A candidate who has passed the two years Pre-University examination conducted by the Pre-University Examination Board in the State of Karnataka or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto by Mangalore University is eligible for admission to these Programmes.

Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)

Candidate for the B.A. Degree Programme shall have passed the Pre-University Examination with any combination of subjects, or equivalent 12th standard examination of any other Board.

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)

Candidate for the B.Sc. Degree Programme shall have studied Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in the Pre-University to take up any Physical Science Programme and Chemistry, Botany and Zoology or Biology to take up any Biological Science Programme.

B.Sc. with Economics combination.

A candidate who has passed PUC or equivalent 12th standard examination conducted by the Pre-University Education Board in the State of Karnataka or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto by Mangalore University with major Mathematics as one of the courses, is eligible for admission to this programme.

Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.)

Only those who have taken Commerce stream in PUC or equivalent 12th standard examination are eligible to apply for B.Com. / B.Com. Professional /B.Com. (B.P.S.) [Business Process Services] offered through TCS.

Those who have taken Science or Commerce stream in PUC or equivalent 12th standard examination are eligible to apply for B.Com. with ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants)

Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.)

B.B.A. (B.P.M.) [Business Process Management] Offered through TCS Candidate for the B.B.A. Degree Programme shall have passed the Pre-University Examination with any combination of subjects, or equivalent 12th standard examination of any other Board.

Bachelor of Computer Applications (B.C.A.)

Candidate for the B.C.A. Degree Programme shall have passed the Pre-University Examination with any combination of subjects, or equivalent 12th standard examination of any other Board.
